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

The emergency departments at CHRISTUS Spohn Hospitals in Corpus Christi include busy regional trauma, stroke and cardiac centers with a wide mix of patient presentations. Students evaluate and treat acutely ill and injured patients as they present to the ED and follow them through their entire emergency department stay.

We offer a 4-week Emergency Medicine rotation to medical students. In addition to direct patient care, students participate in small group learning, hands-on laboratories, and program wide didactics. They enhance their medical knowledge through student-oriented reading assignments, procedure and simulation labs and case conferences. Students ride along with the Corpus Christi Fire Department EMS.

Medical students benefit from a rich clinical patient experience at CHRISTUS Spohn. We encourage students to assume responsibility for the patient care they provide and feel valued as members of the healthcare team. The faculty and resident physicians are dedicated and enthusiastic teachers. Our diverse and complex patient population, extensive opportunities for procedural performance and unique structure of our residency program make our rotation a favorite medical student experience.

To ensure exceptional individual attention for each student, enrollment is strictly limited. We also offer 4-week Emergency Ultrasound and Wilderness Medicine rotations for qualified students.
