The emergency departments at CHRISTUS Spohn Hospitals in Corpus Christi include busy regional trauma, stroke and cardiac centers with a wide mix of patient presentations. Students have the opportunity to evaluate and treat acutely ill patients as they present to the ED and follow them through their entire emergency department stay.

We offer a four-week Emergency Medicine rotation to medical students. In addition to direct patient care, students participate in simulation laboratories, morning reports and weekly residency conferences. They enhance their medical knowledge through student-oriented reading assignments, procedure labs and case conferences. Students may ride with the Corpus Christi Fire Department EMS and have the option of riding with the local aeromedical helicopter provider (HALO).

Medical students benefit from a rich clinical patient experience at CHRISTUS Spohn. We encourage students to assume responsibility for the patient care they provide and feel valued as members of the healthcare team. The faculty and resident physicians are dedicated and enthusiastic teachers.
